Map of Bonn Zone

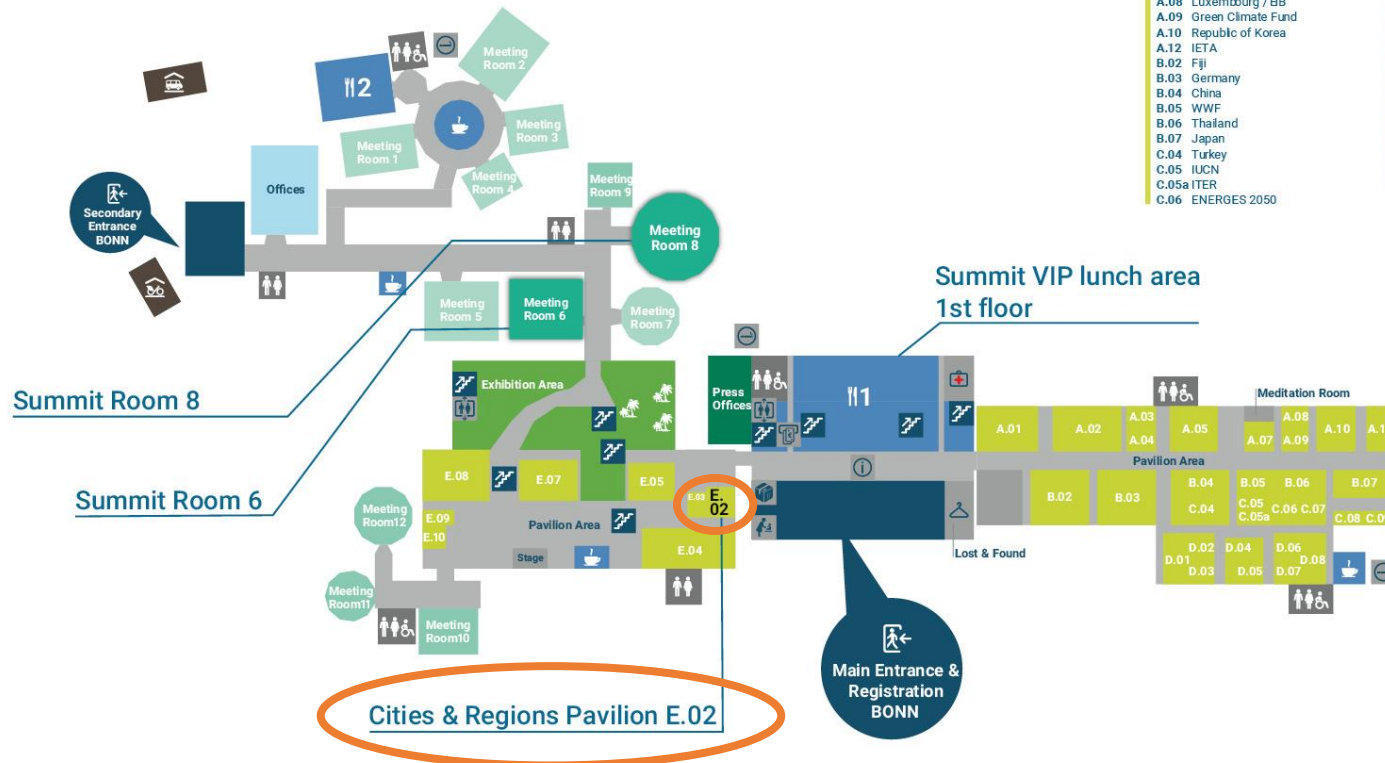
